

Frequently Asked Questions regarding SB 90 & LWVFL

- 1) Suppose someone uses the League's resources **VOTE411.org** to register and has to use the paper form from VOTE411 because they don't have a Florida license or State-issued ID, and thus, cannot register online. Does SB 90 allow the "generic" paper application that is used by VOTE411.org?
 - a) **Yes.**
- 2) Does one need to show the "warnings" before or after they complete the application?
 - a) **Before.**
- 3) Does one need to show the warnings if we register them on our laptops?
 - a) **No. If we register online we are not taking the application with us. It is the act of taking the voter registration application with us that makes us a third party voter organization. We give the warnings when we actually take the completed voter registration application from the person so that we turn it in to the SOE or Div of Elections for them.**
- 4) Can you explain why SOEs are named in the League's lawsuit against SB 90?
 - a) **There was a case a few years ago in which the 11th Circuit overturned an election law case because the Plaintiffs had not named every Supervisor of Election in the case as a Defendant. To make sure that we can win our case, we were required to officially sue every Supervisor, even though some Supervisors are supportive of our claims. The Supervisors understand that we are required to do this.**
- 5) How does it work if the person doesn't have DL#, ID# or the last 4 of SSN?
 - a) **The law requires the numbers to be shown again when there is a change to the voter registration or if it is a new registration. If a person does not have those numbers they need to state that on the application. Their voter registration will need to be verified by the SOE. If it cannot be verified then their vote will be provisional. Verification could be that there is a Drivers license state ID or last four of social security or that none of these exist.**

The statute says nothing more about this. It is best for citizens to get one of these ID's.
- 6) If the SOE can pick up multiple ballots, could the LWV volunteer to help them?
 - a) **Only SOE employees can pick up ballots. It is possible for the SOE to hire League members.**
- 7) The law says you must have either the DL # or the ID # or the last 4 digits of SS. However I see the online form asks for both . Why is this allowed?
 - a) **The form states that they are asking for two numbers to protect against identity theft. If a person does not have two forms of required ID for online registration then they can register in person at SOE.**
